Our instructor for the weekend is Annette Ecuyere who has worked with both amateur and professional writers, in fiction & non as well as education, the world of business and commerce.. Annette will share her love of writing with you and take you on a journey of experimentation and exploration to discover ways of using your senses and emotions, to develop your voice in your writing. You'll be experimenting with different types of writing, including using the senses, rhythm, dialogue, landscape, different roles and points of view, all helping you to develop your own style and confidence. You'll also be reading published works to help you recognise different styles, so do bring along your favourite piece of writing to share. By the end of the weekend you will have discovered new routes into the writer within, and possibly be well on the way to your next novel, as well as having had a really enjoyable few days in a relaxed and friendly environment.”

The weekend takes place at a secluded 16th Century stone farmhouse in the heart of the Welsh countryside with breath-taking views over the Cambrian Mountains.
